- Staff ensure pupil safety/care – duties at break, lunch and after school (engage positively with pupils, forging good relationships; challenge inappropriate behaviour/vocabulary; promote tolerant and respect). Care of environment and each other. 'On Call' used to support pupils to manage their behaviour and support learning.
- Pupils rehearsals (drama) show care for equipment and others
- Positive , assertive discipline behaviour policy: reward system linked to this. Pupils are given responsibility (eg use of phones etc)
- Staff open their classrooms to pupils at lunchtime: informal promotion of respectful interaction
- Film Club

- Pupils support Open Evening
- Theatre trips: Shakespeare Festival, Lord of the Flies, Curious Incident...
- Positive relationships forged with parents through genuine care, face-to-face contact and transparent dialogue/information sharing.
- Staff/pupil relationships allow genuine debate/discussion.
- Debates often used in Y7& Y8 Aspire and many behaviour focussed lessons take place too.
