**END OF TERM – FRIDAY 19<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER 2014**

I am writing to inform you of two changes to our normal routine on the last day of term.

We shall be following our traditional arrangements for the end of the autumn term. The details of these changes are shown below.

As you will see the first four lessons of the day will take place before lunch, which will be served at 12.50pm when the school will close for pupils. (Naturally the Dining Hall will be supervised as normal from 12.50pm for those wishing to have a meal). Our staff meeting will begin at 1.45pm running until approximately 2.45pm.

We have arranged special bus services to Ackworth, Sharlston, Streethouse, New Sharlston, Warmfield and Normanton, these will depart from school at 1.00pm prompt. We have also arranged a special service to Ryhill, Havercroft and Hemsworth which will replace the 194/195 routes. Our expectation is that pupils from Walton will use the normal bus service to Wakefield.

However, should any child experience difficulties travelling we will make full use of the school minibus and other transport to ensure they arrive home safely. I would like to stress to everyone that we expect learning to continue throughout the four lessons indicated above and I would urge you to ensure that pupils attend.

The last day of term will also be a non-uniform day raising funds for the Memusi Foundation. A letter providing further details will follow shortly.

Next term, which begins on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2015 at the normal time of 8.50am, will start with a Week 2, 'Yellow' timetable, continuing the pattern at the end of this term.
