

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The programme is designed for those who have skills and potential to train as teachers. SCITT training is designed to suit individual needs and leads to the award of Qualified Teacher Status.

Qualifications

All qualifications must be gained by 1st September 2014.

- **GCSE** - GCSE Maths and English at Grade C or above. ALL Primary applicants must also have GCSE Science at least Grade C
- **First Degree** - A minimum of a 2:2 classification
- **Degree content** - For Secondary applicants at least 50% of your degree must be in the subject you are wishing to teach.
- **Work Experience** - Minimum 5 days school-based experience in phase applied for.
- **Equivalency Tests** - For applicants who do not have GCSE Maths, English or Science at Grade C or above, equivalency tests from ET Equivalency Testing will be accepted. Further details can be found at www.equivalencytesting.com/options.htm. **Please note:** Equivalency tests must have been undertaken and successfully passed prior to submitting your application.

Applications from candidates with overseas qualifications must have a comparable statement from the National Recognition Information Centre for the UK (UK NARIC) to support their application. Further details about UK NARIC can be found at <http://ecctis.co.uk/naric/>

Skills Tests

You will need to undertake the numeracy and literacy skills tests once you have submitted your application. If you are offered a place, you will be required to produce evidence that you have passed your skills tests prior to starting the course.
