It's a fun, productive and inexpensive way to spend part of their summer holiday. NCS is recognised by UCAS and the experience is great to demonstrate skills to universities, colleges and employers.

The part-residential programme runs for approximately 3 weeks of the summer holidays. Each NCS place is valued at over £1,300 but due to government support we ask for no more than £50, with financial support available if needed.
