

The information below shows the results across the academy over the last 3 years.

### **English and maths.**

The table below shows the proportion of students getting both English and maths at a grade 4 or higher, grade 5 or higher or a grade 7 or higher.

Overall, pupils are improving their grades.

### **Pupils getting the higher grades**

The table shows the percentage of students entered for all exams and the proportion of those achieving the highest grades at either 9-7 or A\*/A.

Each year the number of pupils getting the top grades is improving.

### **Overall grades are improving**

The table below shows the percentage of students achieving a grade 4 or better in 5 subjects that includes English and maths.

As you can see results are improving each year, which obviously means that more pupils are in a strong position for post 16 progression.

Below are two measures the government uses to compare schools, I have used the terminology offered by the government.

### Attainment 8

Schools get a score based on how well pupils have performed in up to 8 qualifications, which include English, maths, 3 English Baccalaureate qualifications including sciences, computer science, history, geography and languages, and 3 other additional approved qualifications.

As you can see the school is improving every year and in 2019 is above the national average.

### Progress 8 score

This score shows how much progress pupils at this school made between the end of key stage 2 and the end of key stage 4, compared to pupils across England who got similar results at the end of key stage 2.

This is based on results in up to 8 qualifications, which include English, maths, 3 English Baccalaureate qualifications including sciences, computer science, history, geography and languages, and 3 other additional approved qualifications.

The table below shows the improvements made over the last 3 years, with the school now similar to the national average.
