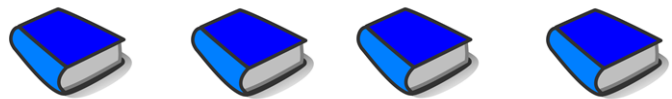


Life and Death: Twilight Reimagined
