Please complete a plan and full story for one of the titles (45 minutes), the whole fiction paper (1 hour) and the questions on the non-fiction texts (30 minutes).

As well as this, use your revision packs (previously given out and in progress books) to learn the stem words and how to answer the questions. Why not read a range of non-fiction texts if you can – newspapers, biographies, magazines, leaflets.

Component 1: Section B (20%)

This section will test creative prose writing through one 40 mark task. **Candidates will be offered a choice of four titles giving opportunities for writing to describe** and narrate, and imaginative and creative use of language.
