

FIRST AID IN SCHOOL

Tell your class teacher (or Reception if outside of lesson time) if you don't feel well



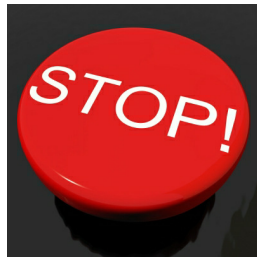
The teacher will give you a note to go to the FIRST AID ROOM next to Main Reception



The First Aiders who will look after you in school are:

Mrs Crookes (Receptionist)
Mrs Bentley (Exams Officer)
Mrs Smith (Pastoral Secretary)
Mrs Hey (Reprographics)
Mrs Hewson (Head of Admin)

DON'T ring or text home yourself, someone from the First Aid Team will do that if they need to



If you are injured the First Aid Team will help patch you up and decide if you need medical help, we will contact home to let them know



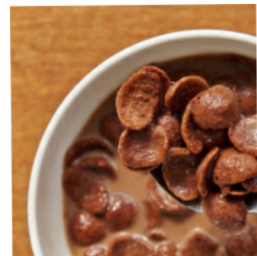
If you are taking medication the First Aid Team can look after this with a note from home explaining when and what you need to take



If you have a medical condition like diabetes or asthma don't worry, the First Aid Team are used to looking after children with lots of different conditions



Always try to eat breakfast before school and drink plenty of water throughout the day



REMEMBER the First Aid Team are not nurses, they cannot diagnose illness, if you're ill before school let someone at home know



There are other staff in school who are first aid trained, but the people above are the ones who will be called out if you need them in an emergency or if you visit the First Aid Room. The Team work closely with your learning mentor to make sure you are properly looked after and Cared for.
